Application Range

Uvijet GS inks are formulated to provide excellent adhesion to flexible materials, giving superb output quality, even at high print speeds. These inks are suitable for a wide range of media such as flexface banners, mesh, blueback or backlit paper, self-adhesive vinyl, backlit films, UV fabrics and many more coated and uncoated media.

Main applications include:

Curing

Excellent cure and adhesion are achieved immediately upon print and UV curing. However, maximum adhesion, chemical, scuff and scratch resistance may not be obtained until 24 hours after initial curing. The actual level of cure will depend upon ink thickness, substrate and the UV lamp settings being used. Superior through cure may be obtained by reducing the print speed to increase the overall UV dose.

Colour and Outdoor Durability

The highest quality pigments have been chosen allowing the inks to produce a wide colour gamut, maximising the range of colours achievable.

Accelerated weathering tests have been carried out in a Xenon Arc Weatherometer set to the SAEJ 1960 Standard. Under these conditions, for the sign and banner market, the accelerated weathering of Uvijet GS inks equates to approximately 24 months outdoor exposure in a temperate climate such as Northern Europe.

Chemical and Abrasion Resistance

Uvijet GS inks have good chemical and abrasion resistance. For optimum print durability it is recommended to over-varnish or laminate prints to protect the surface from abrasion and chemical attack.

Print Head Warranty

Fujifilm warrant that Uvijet GS inks have been formulated to be compatible with the ink supply system of presses and will not cause damage to the print heads, providing these inks are used in accordance with the operating and servicing recommendations in the Acuity Ultra manual and Fujifilm's ink storage conditions.

In the unlikely event that Fujifilm inks are proven to be the cause of a breakdown, then Fujifilm will replace the defective parts. In the case of a claim, any defective part will be subject to analysis in our quality assurance laboratory to determine the cause and extent of damage due to ink performance. This warranty is in addition to that set out in Fujifilm's standard terms and conditions of supply.

Storage

Uvijet GS ink should not be stored in direct sunlight or near heat sources and should be kept away from peroxides. For optimum shelf-life, products should be stored at moderate temperatures between 5°C and 30°C.

When stored in a cool environment the inks are expected to have a shelf-life of 12 months from date of manufacture.
