


# Dear Dog Owners

About Chronic Gastrointestinal disease

When your dog shows gastrointestinal symptoms for more than 3 weeks (defined as chronic), this may be caused by a wide range of diseases. So, comprehensive testing is recommended for proper treatment.



# Has your dog been suffering from the following symptoms for more than 3 weeks? Decreased appetite Weight loss Vomiting Diarrhea



Chronic gastrointestinal symptoms can be caused by gastrointestinal (1-3) and extra-gastrointestinal (4-7) abnormalities.

- Gastrointestinal causes
- 1) Stomach 2) Small intestine 3) Large intestine
- Extra-gastrointestinal causes
- 4 Kidney 5 Liver 6 Pancreas 7 Adrenal

# **Q** What is the cause?

A The main cause is inflammation of the stomach, small intestine, or large intestine.

### **Q** Can it be cured?

A Yes. There are some drugs or dietary therapies that help suppress the disease.

# **Q** What happens if it gets severe?

A For severe cases where the cause is not treated, it takes more time and is more difficult to treat the disease.

### **Q** What tests are necessary?

A To identify the type of disease and where the disease occurs, for example, the following examinations are performed.

- -Physical examination
- -Fecal examination
- -Blood test
- -Urine test
- -Imaging testing (radiography, ultrasonography)
- -Biopsy (collecting a piece of tissue)
