Have you ever worried that your cat is losing weight?





Most common in cats over 8 years of age



Hyperthyroidism



- **Q** What is the cause?
- A It is caused by an increase in thyroid hormone, and the thyroid gland may become enlarged.
- **Q** Can it be cured?
- A The symptoms can often be improved by using anti-thyroid drugs.
 In some cases, the thyroid glands are removed by surgery.
- **Q** What happens if it gets severe?
- A Rapid loss of weight and dehydration may lead to kidney failure.
- **Q** What tests are necessary?
- A blood sample is taken to check the levels of thyroid-related hormones in the blood.

Too much or too little thyroid hormone has a negative impact on cats.
